I have been a part of EFM in 3 states and 1 foreign country. It is an integral part of my life shaping me, challenging me and empowering me to identify my beliefs and then live them out.

EFM is grounding my faith in context of what is actually in the Holy Bible and why, and in all that is inherent in the history of God's people throughout the ages. With the loving support and insights of fellow seekers, I am acquiring my own perspective on God's vision for me, both as an individual and as a member of the faith community.

EFM has given me the opportunity to grow (in) my faith thru readings and discussions with companionable fellows in a safe yet challenging environment. It provides an opportunity to bring questions and concerns forward, and to share experiences, as we attempt to discover who we are in Christ.

EFM has provided a means for me to see the Bible's meaning in light of past and current events. The support and knowledge of the group has been a very important part of the effectiveness of this type of study. I feel enlightened.

I am completing my second year of EFM and another round of great discussions and learning. EFM provides the opportunity for persons of different backgrounds and perspectives to come together and to learn from one another under the guidance of qualified and learned mentors, a truly good place to get a foundation in Scripture, history, and theology.

Education for Ministry has challenged me to explore my faith journey and to develop a deeper relationship with God. I have a greater understanding and appreciation of our Christian heritage.
