Holy Eucharist will be celebrated at 9:00 a.m. followed by the election. Representing St. Mark's in addition to the clergy will be Alex Campbell, Katherine Kingren, and Gwen O'Dea (who represented the parish at the annual February Diocesan Convention and therefore are the lay deputies for the special electing convention).



A designated seating area, separate from the area reserved for deputies, will be available for the press and other interested individuals.

Kids Camp at St. Mark’s

Come join the circus this year! Kids Camp provides structured fun activities within a Christian environment. The program is designed for ages 3 through the completion of 2nd grade. Children must be 3 years old and potty-trained. Classes are grouped by ages with 10-12 children per class and 1 teacher and 2 teen assistants.

This year the circus-themed camp, in its 15th year, runs from June 22 through July 22. It is held Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings from 9:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. St. Mark’s VBS participants will receive a \$25 discount.

Teen helpers are needed for the camp. Youth helpers who are age 14 and older are paid, and helpers ages 13 and under will receive a “thank you” gift. If they choose instead they may earn service hours for school or other organizations for all or part of the hours worked.
